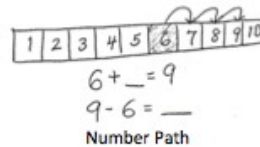
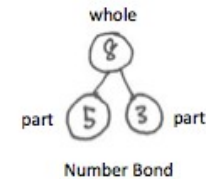
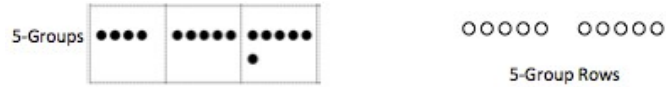


1st Grade Vocabulary for Module 2: Introduction to Place Value Through Addition and Subtraction Within 20

- 5-Groups (as pictured in to the right)
- Addend (one of the numbers being added)
- A ten (Students will focus on putting numbers together to make one ten during this unit.)
- Decompose (breaking a larger number into two smaller numbers)
- Equals (meaning that the numbers or equations on either side of the equal sign have the same value; e.g., $13 = 8 + 5$ or $7 + 6 = 10 + 3$)
- Number bonds (a way to graphically demonstrate how a number can be made up of two smaller numbers)
- Number path (see example below)



- Partners to ten (two numbers that, when added together, make ten; e.g., 2 and 8 or 6 and 4)
- Teen numbers (numbers in the teens such as 13, 16, 18)
