- Endpoint (where something ends, where measurement begins)
- Overlap (extend over, or cover partly)
- Ruler
- Centimeter (cm, unit of length measure)
- Meter
- Meter strip/tape measure (pictured to the right)
- Meter stick
- Hash mark (the marks on a ruler or other measurement tool)
- Number line (a line marked at evenly spaced intervals)
- Non-standard measure (e.g., a paper clip, a finger length, etc.)
- Estimate (an approximation of the value of a quantity or number)
- Benchmark (e.g., "round" numbers like multiples of 10)
- Tape Diagram/comparison picture (a drawing that looks like a segment of tape, used to illustrate number relationships. Also known as a strip diagram, bar model, fraction strip, or length model. See the example to the right.)
